Criteria for the **Enfield Legion Bursary:**

- Resident of the community of Enfield; or, have a family member who is a member of Montgomery Branch # 133 (please indicate the Legion Member's name and Membership Number).
 - NOTE: If the student does not have a family member who is a member of the Legion, but they live in Enfield, they are still eligible to apply for a bursary.
- Grade 12 students of Hants East Rural High School and Lockview High School.
- Acceptance and attendance at a recognized post- secondary educational institution.
- A reference from the High School as to the applicant's potential success at a post-secondary educational institution.
- Information pertaining to the financial need of the applicant.
- A **SINGLE Page** essay telling us about themselves. It may include hobbies, any groups to which they belong, volunteer work and goals for the future. Also, indicate any information on past or current employment and any association with the Royal Canadian Legion (eg Cadets, volunteer work, etc).
- **A copy of the Final Marks for Grade 11, plus first term Grade 12 marks.**

Completion of the **Enfield Legion Bursary Application Form** entitles the student to be considered for a bursary under the Poppy Fund if they are the child/grandchild or great-grandchild of a Veteran of the Canadian Armed Forces, or a bursary from the Enfield Legion General Fund.

NOTE: Only one application form to be completed, and depending on the information provided, the Enfield Legion Bursary Committee will determine eligibility from the Poppy Fund or General Fund.

Students can submit the application form and details via email to enfieldlegion@eastlink.ca or drop off at the branch, 50 Old Enfield Road, Enfield, NS; addressed to the Poppy Chair, Montgomery Br#133. **NO LATER THAN 4 pm on Friday, June 9th, 2017.**

NOTE: Late submissions and/or incomplete applications will not be considered by the Legion.
